Take-off will begin at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light. Weigh-in starts at 3:00 p.m. Sunrise 09/21/2019 – 6:50 a.m. Sunrise 09/22/2019 – 6:51 a.m. <u>Site Hosts</u> Connecticut Bass Federation & Clayton, NY.</p>	<p><u>Required Items and Safety Equipment</u> It is the responsibility of each participant to have ALL required state and federal safety equipment on board as well as, ALL permits licenses, passes or stamps, Etc. required. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to properly display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch. Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p>
<p><u>Fish Limits</u> Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted Bass 12" inches and over. Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per person unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8 ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.</p>	<p><u>Tournament Directors</u> Amy Perry (860)398-0215 Fram4tbf@sbcglobal.net <u>Required:</u> Anglers will need a New York Fishing License; Pass port and Canadian Outdoors Card & Fishing License. More info at ct-tbf.com on National Semi Finals Page.</p>	<p><u>Boundaries</u> Tournament waters are OFF limits Monday, and Tuesday, prior to the event. Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday are practice days. Saturday and Sunday are competition days (Read the rules) Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>
