Advancement from this event based on numbers

1 boater and 1 co-angler advances from this event to the 2020 Federation National Championship From: **South Carolina and North Carolina**

- Any big fish pots are on the side collected on site and handled locally
- **Payback is over 100% in cash and prizes in total, goal is to give the winner's enough money to make the trip to the FNC for the most part**
- Everyone gets a National Semi Final qualifier jersey for this event.
- 49 boats to account for \$9,800 in boater's fees, \$4,900 in co-anglers fees

National Payout Breakdown

75% payback to 20% of the field of anglers = (Boaters \$7,350, Cos \$3,675)

10% to states for expenses (Boaters \$980, Co \$490)

15% to Federation Championship (Boaters \$1,470, Co \$735)
