Overview:

The 2020 TBF National Championship is the ultimate dream for any angler. Each of the 7 TBF Division Champion Boaters and Co-anglers will receive a "Living the Dream" prize package. The top Boater and Co-angler will earn the National Champion titles and the lion's share of the largest payout in federation history. Held on Oklahoma's fabled Grand Lake O' the Cherokees, this no entry fee event consisting of 54 Boaters and 54 Co-anglers representing every TBF state & provincial federation and all 7 TBF divisions in North America. These top anglers competed during 2019 and earned their spots through a series of TBF club, state and one of 22 close to home TBF National Semi-Final events to earn a spot in the 2020 TBF National Championship.

- Everyone gets something – prize list extends to all boaters and co-angler (108 anglers)
- Every angler receives Housing/Motel provided at TBF cost for qualified official event days.
- Ranger Cup - MULTIPLE Ranger Cup contingency cash prizes for both boaters and co-anglers.
- All 54 Boater's receive a boat gas stipend for each competition day they fish to help offset costs.

Format:

- **Prize purse** – Over \$350,000.00 in cash, bonus’s and prizes will be awarded
- **Days 1 & 2 – Full Field; Boaters & Co-anglers, compete and weigh-in at Wolf Creek Ramp 3pm CST**
 - 54 Boaters and 54 Co-anglers compete representing the 7 TBF Divisions
- **Day 3 – Top 7 Boaters & Co-anglers compete and weigh in at 3:00pm CST**
 - 7 Division-Champion Boaters and 7 Division-leading Co-anglers based on accumulated weight from days one and two. ALL 14 advance to the 2020 BFL All-American
 - Winning Boater and Co-angler determines National Champions titles by the accumulated weight from days one through three and wins National Champions prize packages.

Key Rules:

- Off-Limits begins Monday February 24, 2020, Official practice days are March 9,10,11
- Each angler may weigh in five bass per day.
- Oklahoma fishing license is required
- 14” length limit
- Only artificial lures are permitted
- Bass must be kept alive. Anglers are assessed an 8-ounce penalty for each bass brought to the weigh-in not alive
- Anglers who are late for the official check-in are assessed a 1 pound-per-minute penalty
