<p align="center"><u>Registration/Rules Meeting/Banquet</u></p> <p>Location: Stoney Creek Inn & Conference Center 101 18th Street Moline, IL 61265</p> <p>Date: Tuesday, July 27th 2021</p> <p>Registration Times: 5:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. 6:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins.</p> <p>No teams are allowed to be on the water without TD approval after 3:00pm on Registration Day.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Launch/Weigh-In</u></p> <p>Launch Location: Shuler’s Shady Grove Ramp 1128 1st Avenue Rapids City, IL 61278</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 6:00 a.m. or first safe light thereafter.</p> <p>Weigh-in begins: 2:00 p.m.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Required Items and Safety Equipment</u></p> <p>It is the responsibility of each participant to have ALL required state and federal safety equipment on board as well as, ALL permits licenses, passes or stamps, Etc. required.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to properly display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Anglers 16 and older are required to have a valid Illinois fishing license/permit. Non-residents under 16 may fish without a license.</p>
<p align="center"><u>Fish Limits</u></p> <p>Largemouth and smallmouth Bass 12" inches and over this Junior youth event.</p> <p>Team is allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per team unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials.</p> <p>Fish presented which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>

Three (3) people are required in every boat. NO exceptions.</p> <p>PRE-TOURNAMENT PRACTICE: The JWC waters will go off-limits at Sundown Saturday July 17 until the first official practice day Monday July 26, (the MONDAY before the first competition day). YOU MAY NOT have anyone practicing for you during the off-limits time. There will be (2) designated practice days if you choose to practice either those 2 designated practice days the junior team and the registered boat captain must do so from the same boat. The two (2) designated practice days shall be Monday and Tuesday July 26, 27 ONLY. All anglers must be off plane in in sight of the launch ramp, no longer fishing and getting off the water by 3:00pm local time on Tuesday July 27 PRIOR to the first competition day. The lake will go back off-limits to all competitors until the tournament begins.</p>
