Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted Bass 15" inches and over. Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per person unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.
