All anglers must be off the water by 3:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

## **Fish Limits**

Largemouth and smallmouth Bass 14" inches and over.

Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish per person unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.

## **Required Items and Safety Equipment**

It is the responsibility of each participant to have ALL required state and federal safety equipment on board as well as, ALL permits' licenses, passes or stamps, etc. required.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to properly display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

A valid Michigan fishing license and US Coast Guard approved signal flares and flotation device, working Horn, Fire Extinguisher, Launch Permit, and Michigan Recreation Passport is required. Ontario Providence fishing license if fishing in Canadian Waters. Walpole Indianan Reservation license if fishing in Walpole Indiana Reservation.

## **Boundaries**

All Lake St Clair can be fished as well as attached waters. .

Tournament waters are OFF limits Monday, and Tuesday, prior to the event. Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday are practice days. Saturday and Sunday are competition days (Read the rules)

Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
