

TBF District 13 DE-MD-DC – Nanticoke Rvr, Laurel, DE National Semi-Finals Payout & Advancement Sheet

Advancement from this event based on numbers

1 boater and 1 co-angler advances from this event to the 2026 Federation National Championship From: Delaware, Maryland, and National Capitol

- Any big fish pots are on the side collected on site and handled locally
- **Payback is over 100% in cash and prizes in total, goal is to give the winner's enough money to make the trip to the FNC for the most part**
- Everyone gets a National Semi Final qualifier jersey for this event.
- 35 boats to account for \$7,000 in boater's fees, \$3,500 in co-angler's fees

National Payout

75% payback to 20% of the field of anglers = (Boaters \$5,250, Cos \$2,625)

10% to states for expenses (Boaters \$700, Co \$350)

15% to Federation Championship (Boaters \$1,050, Co \$525)

Therefore 35 teams 20% is 7 places paid as follows
